



- Removed Empty Option For Response Dropdown



- New Setting Reach out to support to enable
- Creates a new measure under Highest/Latest Score with Test Grade
- Districts can now optionally hide Tested Grades Folder and retain that information






Data Updates



Optionally Remove Nested Months

- New Setting Reach out to Support to Enable
- Removes Tested Months from Tested Grades folder & Replaces with Highest/Latest Score
- Removes ambiguity from districts that do not want to see re-tests

Item Duration And Pause Logging

What it is


Updating Assessment Reporting to include the time spent by the student on each item and the number of pauses a student made on their assessment.

Student Item Analysis will have a new tab that displays a student Item Duration breakdown and Assessment Completion Report to include a count of Pauses.

Why we think you will like it

Test administrators can audit student online testing and identify patterns that need mitigation like accommodations required, significant time on an item, or frequent pauses causing disruption to the assessment experience.








Number Line Interaction Type

What it is

A new auto-scored interaction type for student online testing to assess their understanding of math problems which can be used to represent any quantity that can be measured in discrete units.

Why we think you will like it

Expanded support for math interaction types supported in item creation to improve student's outcomes in mathematics over time






Standards Report

Standards Report is a new Report that will show *Aggregated Assessment Results by Standard* to represent mastery at a class, school and district level. New Reporting features include:

Mastery Comparison - Review mastery on a Doman and it's children

Time Analysis – Analyze growth or decay over time on a standard

Details – Review how a standard has been tested, including performance by item interaction & attribute








Comparative Results Report



Only for PM assessments (Common Assessments)

- ➤ You can choose 1 test or multiple tests to compare
- ➤ You have the option to compare Standards, DOK, Taxanomy, Subject or Question Interactions
- Comparison Variable include Districts, Schools, Teachers and Classes





Comparative Results Report: Comparisons

- View and Compare overall test scores based on the filters you applied
- ➤ View and Compare by standards, DOK, QI, etc.
- Use this data in PLCs and have teachers share what is working and what they may need assistance with





Comparative Results Report: Students

- View students' overall test score, as well as how they performed on each standard
- ➤ Use this data to create small groups or to assign standard specific practice







