

What Are Badges?

 Badges can be used to track Professional Development beyond individual course completion.



Main Ways Badges Are Used

Gamification

• Easy to earn, Fun to collect, Friendly competition

Achievement Badge

• Less easy to earn, Carry some weight beyond the badge itself

Micro-Credential

• More difficult to earn, More value is placed on them from the district level

The more effort to earn a badge, the more value placed on the badge

Types of Badges

Automatic


 Badge is automatically added to the user once the required courses for badge have been completed

Manual

- Needs final approval once the required courses for the badge have been completed
- Usually requires evidence
- *Approver must be the Badge Creator or a Badge Super


Manual Assigning

Example: Create a Badge for Playlist Completion

Build a Playlist with required or optional courses

Build a Badge to match requirements

Badge is automatically assigned during registration for first course, and earned once final course is completed
