

PowerSchool SIS PowerScheduler: Load Priority

Load priority is the order in which courses will be loaded for a student. Use Load priority to prioritize in which course the system should schedule a student when a conflict between two of the student's requests arises. The lower the number, the higher the priority.

NOTE: The following example is just a recommendation.

- 1** - **AP, Honors, Band, Choir** (Singletons offered once per year, or doubletons offered twice per year)
- 3** - **Year-Long Required** (High priority as yearlong courses need more room in the schedule)
- 7** - **Year-Long Electives** (High priority as yearlong courses need more room in the schedule)
- 15** - **Semester Long Required**
- 31** - **Semester Long Electives**
- 63** - **Fluff stuff like Study Hall, Independent Study, etc.**

Note: On the Preferences tab of the Courses screen, you can enter only a 2-digit Load priority. Use the Update Selections tool to set a 3-digit Load priority.
